Parking will be sign posted.

We have The Blue Lagoon Public House 50 yards away if you require food and drink, and there are toilet facilities there, and also at the other end of the Lagoon,

If wet, there is some shelter around our club house. We hope that the conditions will be ideal, sunny with a good wind no fog, rain, ice or other excuses to prevent us giving you a good day's racing!

Ray Baxter will be the PRO, Footy class rules will apply and the racing will be conducted using the RRS 2005-2008 modified by sailing instructions that relate to EORS 2001. The relevant notices are as follows:

REGISTRATION and measurement check 08.40 to 09.30 hours.

BRIEFING - this will start at approximately 09.40 hours.

RACING TIMES - the first race will start soon after the briefing at approximately 10.00 hours - no race will start after 15.15 hours and any race in progress at 15.45 hours will be abandoned.

Copies of EORS 2001 and related SIs will be available on the day. It is similar to HMS used in MYA events, but is more flexible in allowing any number of boats to sail in a single fleet. Please remember to bring your MYA membership card if you have one. Please make sure that your correct sail numbers are clearly displayed on both mainsails. When you bring your boat for registration, please make sure it can be checked in the 'Footy measurement box' with the small rig fitted.

The entry fee will be £3.00, to be paid on the day. Entries and any queries should go to Tony Lambert and may be either phoned through on **01444 870758** or e-mailed to [tl@uwclub.net](mailto:tl@uwclub.net) before midnight on **Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2008**. The information required is your name, club, sail number, **radio frequency that you have in your boat** and **the alternative frequencies available**. Please pass this notice onto those you know who might like to participate. If they have no Footy, we have some that may be borrowed. Please ring Tony as soon as you can to avoid disappointment.
